FCC Amends EAS, Includes Amber Info

The Federal Communications Commission has adopted a Report and Order amending the Emergency Alert System (EAS) rules. The Commission adopted several new EAS event and location codes (FIPS codes), including a new Child Abduction Emergency event code which may be used to activate Amber Plans. Broadcast Engineer Relief Fund Update

The Broadcast Engineer Relief Fund to benefit families of the six broadcast engineers lost at the World Trade Center on September 11 has received a great response. Initiated by the Society of Broadcast Engineers and the Ennes Educational Foundation Trust on September 13, the Fund has received more than \$247,000 as of February 4. The SBE has dispensed funds to the families as the fund has received donations. The first checks were sent last October, and as of February 4 each family has received \$41,000 in unrestricted grants. Every dollar contributed to the Broadcast Engineer Relief Fund goes to the six families. SBE and the Ennes Trust are absorbing any expenses related to the fund.

As the financial loss for many of these families is very large, the SBE continues to accept tax-deductible contributions.
