IP Audio Coding. Chris Crump from Comrex will discuss IP audio coding for transmission of broadcast-quality audio. The discussion will include an overview of BRIC (Broadcast Reliable Internet Codec) Technology and how it enables broadcasters to use the public Internet to transmit reliable, real-time, high quality and fully bidirectional audio. Since BRIC Technology was first introduced in 2005, Comrex has added several features to its Access product line, including the BRIC Traversal Server and the new BRIC-Link codec for dedicated links. Applications such as STL/dedicated studio links utilizing ISM band radios, satellite data services and high-speed wired or wireless dedicated IP data circuits will also be discussed. Crump will also cover the Comrex BRIC UDP Transmission Enhancement (BRUTE), which provides UDP reliability and congestion avoidance on difficult data circuits such as Wi-fi and 3G wireless data services.

Lunch will be provided by Comrex. Join us in the meeting room located in the back of the restaurant.

Last Month's Meeting

The November meeting of SBE59 of the Society of Broadcast Engineers was held Nov. 12, 2009 at Don Chilito's Restaurant in Mission, KS. There were 9 in attendance. Dave Buell, chapter vice chairman, was in charge.

Buell opened the business meeting at 12:09 p.m. Ben Weiss read the minutes of the October meeting. Then Weiss provided the treasurer's report. The motion to accept the minutes and the financial report was by Kirk Chestnut and the second was by Chriss Scherer. Passed.

Kirk Chestnut, KC area EAS chairman, remarked that there have been no recent EAS issues in the market. There was a brief discussion regarding the NAL issued by the FCC to San Clemente, CA, station KWVE for failing to properly execute an EAS RMT. KWVE is the LP-1 for the area and the station operator inadvertently sent a RMT without the closing EOM. The FCC considered the error an infraction serious enough to stick the station with a \$5,000 fine. Since stations across the nation agree to be LP1 or LP2 stations on a voluntary basis the question was posed as to why any station would want to subject themselves to a potential FCC fine if something goes wrong with a monthly test. [Note - the FCC has since rescinded the fine and admonished the licensee for the error.]

Chriss Scherer, chapter certification chairman, indicated that Dec. 31 is the deadline to register for the February certification exams. Scherer, who serves on the SBE national board of directors and is the chapter liaison to SBE59, then presented the SBE award for best chapter website to John Gray. Scherer had accepted the award on behalf of Gray and the chapter at the annual SBE national convention in Verona, NY.

The motion to adjourn was by Chriss Scherer and the second by John Gray.

Greg Best, consulting engineer and chapter member, pre-

sented the program that addresses the proposed FM IBOC digital power increase and he demonstrated FM IBOC mask measurements using a Rohde & Schwartz ETL spectrum analyzer.
